

Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act Enrollment Notice

If you have had or are going to have a mastectomy, you may be entitled to certain benefits under the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 (WHCRA). For participants or beneficiaries who are receiving benefits under the plan in connection with a mastectomy and who are electing breast reconstruction, coverage will be provided in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and patient, for:

- all stages of reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed;
- surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance;
- · prostheses; and
- treatment of physical complications for all stages of the mastectomy, including Lymphedemas (swelling associated with the removal of lymph nodes).

These benefits will be provided subject to the same deductibles and coinsurances applicable to other medical and surgical benefits provided under the plan. These provisions are generally described in the plan's Summary Plan Description (SPD).
